Gift Aid UK Taxpayers

Co-operation Ireland can claim back the tax element of donations made to our charity, by PAYE or self assessed taxpayers which amounts to an extra 25% at no cost to them. Should you wish our charity to reclaim the tax back on donations made, simply tick the Gift Aid box. You must pay an amount of income tax and/or capital gains tax equal to the tax we reclaim on your donation.

Republic of Ireland Taxpayers

Tax paid on donations of €250 or more made directly to Co-operation Ireland by PAYE taxpayers who are not directly related to the participant or to the participant's spouse, can be reclaimed by our charity. The additional amount reclaimed by Co-operation Ireland will vary according to the tax band of the donor (e.g. 20% or 42%). Should the donor wish our charity to reclaim the tax back on donations made tick the box and Co-operation Ireland will forward the relevant form to the donor for completion.

Why Raise Sponsorship for Co-operation Ireland?

Co-operation Ireland's vision is for a peaceful stable island where cultural and political differences are respected and where people of all backgrounds can live and work together for a better future. All sponsorship raised will help the charity achieve its vision and support its work with schools, youth clubs and community groups, giving people from diverse communities within Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland, a chance to meet and spend time together so that they can learn to accept and respect each other's traditions and cultures.

Unfortunately many barriers still exist to the normalisation of relationships in society between communities within Northern Ireland and between Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland. Co-operation Ireland focuses its programmes on tackling head on any obstacle in the path to a sustainable and lasting peace shared by all the peoples on the island of Ireland. It currently has approximately 30 programmes working to this end.

One of the current projects, the Youth Leadership programme, has been set up in response to the growing evidence of the vulnerability of young people in communities throughout the island to participate in criminal and anti-social activities.

A three stranded approach has been adopted in developing the programme in partnership with local communities. Young people are brought through a series of activities designed to enhance their self-esteem and their opinion of their local community. They receive high quality work placements to build their skills and raise their aspirations and finally they have long term mentors who guide and advise them when they return to their own locality. The Youth Leadership programme aims to give young people a chance to use their leadership qualities as a positive force for change in their local environment and move away from anti-social behaviour and gang culture.

Co-operation Ireland plans to roll out this programme to 30 geographical locations throughout Northern Ireland and the Republic of Ireland effectively intervening to promote positive youth leadership to up to 1000 young people.
